## ORDER OF COORDINATION

Merrill Lynch & Co., et al., H-05-0774, charging various financial institution Defendants under Texas state law with participation in or critical assistance to fraud perpetrated by Special Purpose Entity LJM2 by means of Defendants' agreement to provide equity capital to or lend money to LJM2 breach of fiduciary duty, was removed from the 193<sup>rd</sup> Judicial District Court of Dallas County, Texas to the United States Bankruptcy Court in the Northern District of Texas on "related to" bankruptcy jurisdiction grounds, and subsequently transferred to this Court by the Judicial Panel for Multidistrict Litigation for inclusion in MDL 1446.
